

In-Person Colour Analysis What to Expect

Location

We are located in Muskoka, Ontario, Canada, the heart of cottage country, only a 2.5-hour drive north of Toronto. Studio

Our dedicated colour studio is a fusion of elegant style and the quintessential, comfortable, and relaxed ambience of cottage country. It is designed for private and personalized attention throughout the Personal Colour Analysis process and the consultations that follow.

Clothing

Wear what makes you comfortable. To ensure our focus is on your face and your skin, you'll be wearing a cape in a neutral grey colour and your hair will be covered for a portion of the consultation. Note - it is helpful when your shirt doesn't have a collar. This allows your neck to be visible during the analysis.

A Bare, Uncovered Face

It is important to show your natural skin tone. Wear no make-up at all, not even moisturizer or lip balm. Wear no sunless tanning products. It's best if it's been a couple of weeks since application. During the analysis, we ask that you don't wear glasses. Tie your hair back or style it off your face so your whole face is visible. If you wear a hijab or head scarf, wear a neutral grey colour if you happen to have one in your wardrobe. If not, we are happy to provide a head covering in the colour necessary for an ideal analysis.

Time

An in-person colour analysis consultation lasts approximately 3-4 hours.

Grey Surroundings

To create the ideal circumstances for Personal Colour Analysis (PCA), the process takes place in grey surroundings that will have the least possible influence on your own colouring, which ensures no interference in the analysis and the most accurate result possible. A neutral grey is the colour of the room; the cape that covers your clothing; the scarf that is used to cover your hair; and the clothing of your analyst.

Lighting

During the analysis, to make certain we catch every reaction to a variety of colour tests, we create the ideal environment by using bright lights of a high colour rendering index and a Kelvin temperature that represents natural daylight and a clear sky.

Draping

Draping is a process of placing two fabrics of different and deliberate colours across your shoulders and under your face for the purpose of comparing the effects of each drape on your appearance. The analyst works collaboratively with you through 30 to 50 comparisons, taking note of changes in your facial contour, clarity, skin smoothness, and many other observations about your features. Your analyst eliminates colours and colour groupings based on decisions made at each step of the process until you arrive at your Colour Season and your Seasonal Colour Palette.

Photos

We take many photos throughout the Personal Colour Analysis process to capture every reaction to colour; to collect data for future reference and for teaching materials; and to celebrate how outstanding you look in your personal colour palette! Your Seasonal Colour Palette

We introduce you to your Seasonal Colour Palette and the analyst gives you some tips and recommendations about how to apply your colours to your clothes, makeup, and hair.

Clothing and/or Cosmetic Samples

You are welcome to bring up to 6 total of your go-to clothing and/or cosmetic items. As part of the consultation, we'll determine whether these go-to items fit within your personal colour palette.

Cosmetics
