## COLOUR CHARACTERISTICS:

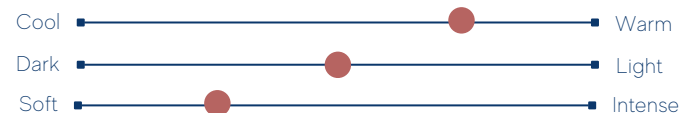
Hue: All colour families are represented in all seasons. Your best versions of red, yellow, green, blue, and purple are determined by the temperature, value, saturation, and intensity as follows.

Temperature: Warm Neutral; a hint of cool

Value: Medium

Saturation: Moderate

Intensity: Soft, Muted (mixed with grey)



## IMAGE:

Medium intensity and contrast, coppery, woody, mossy, some richness, and some spice

## COLOUR CHARACTERISTICS TO AVOID:

Intense; Bright; Cool

## JEWELLERY:

Metals in yellow gold, antique, brass, copper, and bronze

Natural materials, such as wood, tortoise shell, pearls in cream

Gemstones in natural stones that blend with your colour palette
